

CHILDREN'S GARDEN AT THE INTERNATIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL, Pawtucket, RI

Project Description

GCD designed and built a school garden for this tri-lingual elementary school in 2007. We manage the school garden program and work with teachers on curriculum integration. Kindergarten students plant lettuce in April and eat salad in June before they leave. Other grades plant gardens in the spring (salsa garden, potato patch, pizza garden, etc.) and harvest when they return in the fall. Students drew plans of their ideal school gardens during the design phase and (while we were not able to incorporate the water slide or the petting zoo) student artwork served as inspiration for metal sculptures in the garden.
